



School Leadership Opportunities for Pupils

Our children understand that we belong to a local and global community and the sense of responsibility that comes with belonging. We provide opportunities for pupils to take on leadership roles in order to empathise and make a small sacrifice to benefit others.

Pupils play an active role as courageous advocates throughout school, promoting: commitment, opportunity, respect and excellence in the everyday life of the school and its community. Examples of pupil leadership are listed below:

- Team Point Captains – responsible for motivating and encouraging peers throughout their school lives.
- Team Point Vice Captains – there to support the captain and take on greater responsibilities in their absence.
- School Council – the school council frequently meet to discuss current issues/opportunities. Suggesting initiatives and planning fundraising events for numerous charities (Both local and global).
- Sports Ambassadors – These pupils support the delivery of some Physical Education lessons, they support the PE coordinator with the delivery of some sporting events including Sports Day and equipment at playtimes throughout the school year.
- Year 3/4 and year 6 reading buddies – these pupils support younger pupils with their reading.
- Peer Support Group – these pupils monitor the happiness and well-being of pupils on a day to day basis. Reporting any concerns to relevant members of staff.
- Collective Worship/assembly Monitors – the year 6 pupils are alternated through the year to aid in the delivery of collective worship, help set up and assess effectiveness.
- Digital Leaders (Year 4 group) – these pupils monitor the laptop trolley with support of the Computing coordinator.
- Playground leaders – these pupils work with a specialist sports coach to deliver activities at lunchtimes throughout the week. They plan and deliver games to encourage all pupils to be active and lead healthy lifestyles.

- Classroom Monitors – throughout the year, pupils are selected in every year group/class to take on various responsibilities, ensuring respect for school equipment is consistently shown and high standards are maintained.
