Partnership for Inclusion of Neurodiversity in Schools (PINS) programme – As you will be aware we have been lucky enough to be chosen to participate in the above project with the NHS and North Yorkshire Council. Across the County only 8 schools, including ourselves will work together in this project that aims to improve support for children with additional needs. Special Educational Needs and/or Disability (SEND) is defined as any child that has a learning difficulty or disability that makes it harder for a child to learn compared to children of the same age. Children with Special Educational Needs (SEN) are likely to need extra or different help from that given to other children their age. This help is known as special educational provision - no diagnosis or EHCP is required.

As part of the programme we will hold termly meetings in order to: ● Work cooperatively with the school ● Ensure that parents and carers have their voices heard by the school ● Bring parents and carers together to share experiences ● Facilitate guest speakers to discuss SEND specific topics.

At the meeting we will be planning how our sessions will run for the next academic year, and what parent carers would like to theme sessions on. **The meeting will be held on Thursday 20th June 2024 starting at 9.15am in School** We appreciate a large number of parents and carers, care for younger/older siblings during the day; you are more than welcome to bring them along under your responsibility. You can drop in to the meeting for as long or little as you wish, we will be there for up to 2 hours.
