# Honouring Pte Foxton: A Special Memorial at St Helen's Church

On Thursday, members of our school community had the honour of attending a moving memorial service at St Helen's Church to celebrate and commemorate the life and legacy of Pte Foxton.



Remarkably, despite Emmanuel J Foxton's service and ultimate sacrifice—having died from wartime injuries—he lay in an unmarked grave for 106 years, without formal recognition. Thanks to dedicated research, this injustice was finally addressed, and a proper headstone was placed by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission, ensuring Pte Foxton is now remembered with the dignity deserved, just ahead of Remembrance Sunday.

A group of our pupils took part in the service, with one child given the special responsibility of laying a wreath in remembrance. Others had the opportunity to speak with



our local MP, Keir Mather, representatives from the local media and war veterans. The children were outstanding ambassadors for our school, sharing thoughtful reflections with both the media and war veterans.

The service was attended by military personnel from the West Yorkshire Regiment, as well as Selby MP Keir Mather. A poignant moment was marked by a bugler playing The Last Post, honouring the sacrifices made. Thank you to all the children involved, your conduct and words made us extremely proud- as they always do.

Last week, our staff team attended their first YLT Moderation meeting. This was a valuable opportunity for colleagues to come together and share samples of children's writing across year groups. It was inspiring to see the range of work produced and to engage in professional dialogue around standards and progression. These sessions help us ensure consistency and celebrate the achievements of our pupils.
