The tree forms part of the York Minster Christmas Tree Festival, 70 trees throughout the Minster that have been decorated by schools and various organisations in York and will be on display until 5<sup>th</sup> January. Our tree is in the Chapter House Vestry, entry to which is just to the left of the Astronomical Clock.

If you are a York resident, then entry to the Minster (and the tree festival) is free. It is a lovely and reflective event so please call in to see the Christmas trees if you are able to. #### **Christmas Events for Parents/Carers**

This week, parents of children in **Reception and Year 1** will receive 2 tickets per family per Christmas performance. To attend the events, you will need a ticket, and this includes any younger siblings who you may bring to watch the plays. You can swap tickets amongst yourselves, but we have no spare tickets to issue.

Please may we ask for consideration during the performances, to turn off mobile phones, camera flashes and if you have any preschool children that become unsettled, please leave the hall until they are calm. We ask that any photos taken are not to be shared on social media but are for personal use only.

For all **Key stage 2** events tickets are not issued but there is a limit of 2 per family coming to watch.

These restrictions are in place to comply with health and safety regulations, so we politely ask that you respect this. Thank you.
