Dear Parents and Carers,

As we are all aware regular attendance is essential for all children during their primary and secondary education. The attendance of every child is important and we aim to ensure that every child knows their presence is valued and they are missed when absent. Good attendance and punctuality are essential to promote the education of all pupils and we aim for every child to have an attendance of 97% and above.

Every minute counts! (Figures below are calculated over a school year)

5 minutes late each day	= 2.75 days lost
10 minutes late each day	= 5.5 days lost
15 minutes late each day	= 8.25 days lost
20 minutes late each day	= 11 days lost
30 minutes late each day	= 16.5 days lost
